

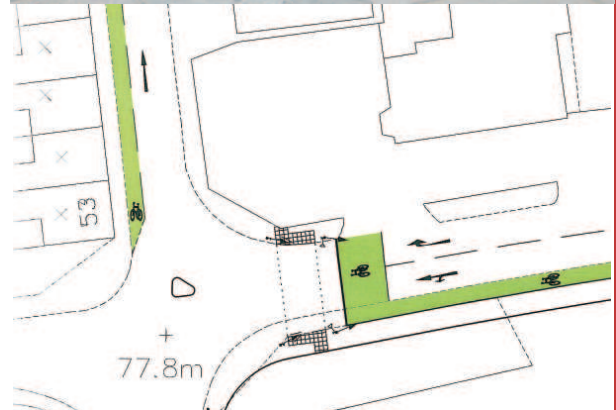
Cycling and Walking

The Government's White Paper 'Creating Growth, Cutting Carbon: Making Sustainable Local Transport Happen', published in January 2011, sets out the Government's vision for a sustainable local transport system that supports the economy and reduces carbon emissions. The White Paper seeks to encourage improvements to the quality of local environments and a culture where cycling and walking are seen as attractive alternatives to car travel for short journeys.
